### LAST WEEK – YANDELORA – ANA LEVAR



Ana Levar is a vision support teacher whose job is itinerant, which means she travels between schools to support students with vision impairment.

Ana shared her passion for education with us on Thursday night and all Rotarians were fascinated by her knowledge, experience and passion. Ana spoke at length about a particular type of vision impairment known as Cortical Vision Impairment (CVI) which relates to the brain’s inability to read the messages that the eyes send.

Ana spends most of each Friday at Yandelora School where she teaches staff to support the students with vision impairments and develops resources to support the students.

Rotarians also got to see the incredible resources the District Grant and Club funds was able to provide the students at Yandelora School to support students with vision impairment to develop skills in literacy.


